BIG RED MIKE led early in hand, set a pressured pace, quickened on the turn and drew clear at the top of the stretch then held sway under a drive. HOTEPE stalked early then moved up and forced the pace on the backstretch and far turn, chased into the stretch, was all out but failed to catch the winner. ROAN INISH raced midpack, closed late backstretch, chased between foes on the turn and finished under an all out drive. GIANT'S TOMB raced off the pace, closed outside rivals on the far turn, cut inward at the top of the stretch and rallied gamely. MOBTHEWARRIOR, off a step slowly, raced in the middle of the pack, chased hard on the turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out in the final yards. DARK CLOUD DANCER stalked from the inside, chased on the far turn then flattened out in the final furlong. SMART SKY, well back early, was hustled through the far turn but never reached contention. MOMENT OF MAJESTY, in range, was hustled on the far turn, came eight-wide into the stretch and tired. WHO WE GUNNA CALL raced midpack, backed away late on the far turn then failed to menace. MOBILIZER, in touch early, stalked the pace, chased three-deep on the far turn then tired upper stretch. GHOST FLEET was in touch to the far turn and tired. VICAR STREET, well back through out, was hustled along the rail on the far turn then tired in the stretch. D'S WANDO raced off the pace, was hustled from early turn and roused midturn but had no late response.
